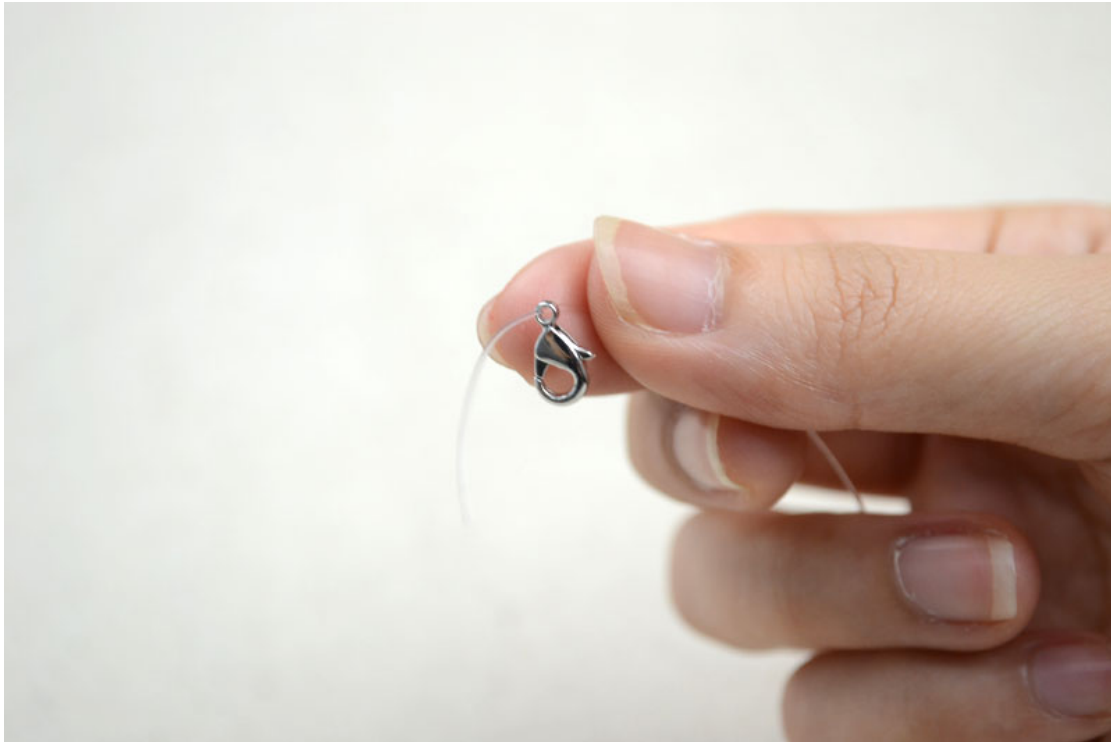
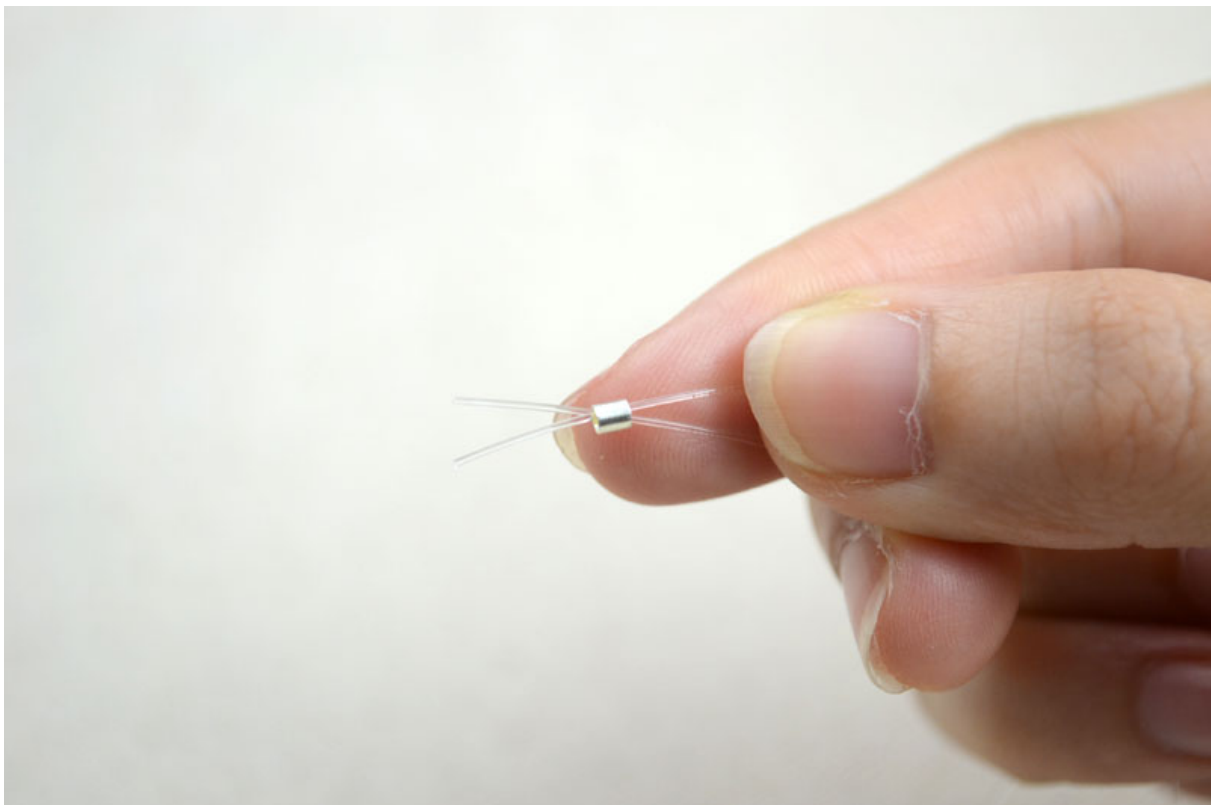


FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS CRIMP BEAD

Step1: Thread a nylon wire through the circle of a lobster claw clasp.



Step2: Grasp the two ends of the nylon wire and thread them together through a crimp bead.



Step3: Position the crimp bead under the lobster claw clasp.



Step4: Clip the crimp bead slightly with flat nose plier.



Step5: Continue clipping tight until it can't slip on the nylon wire.



Step6: Use two flat nose pliers to bend the crimp bead towards the middle of it.



Step7: Clip the two ends of the crimp bead together with flat nose plier.



Step8: So we have finished the start of your jewelry.



FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS END TIPS

Instructions:

Step1: squeeze some glue into a cord end.



Step2: Put a chain's end in the cord end.



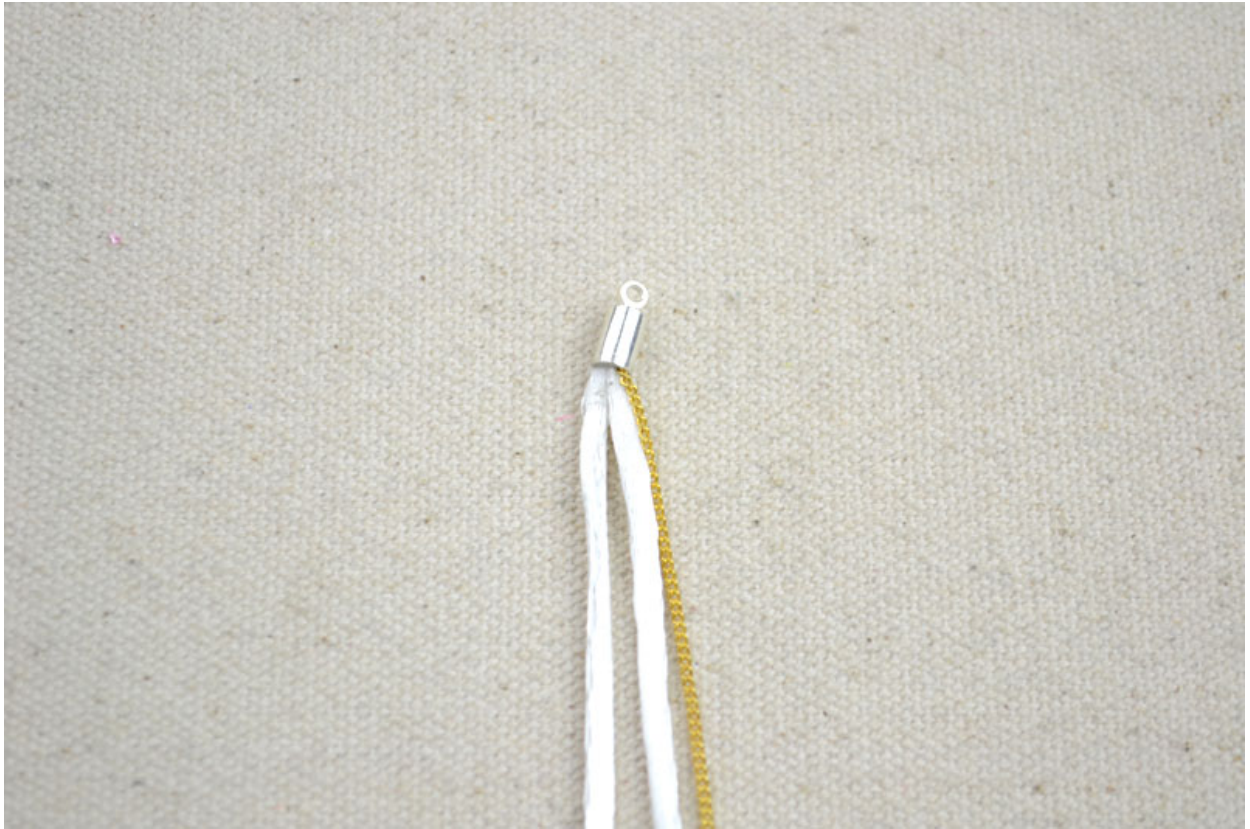
Step3: Put a rope into the cord end.



Step4: Put another rope into the cord end.



Step5: when the glue is dry, you have done!



FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS JUMPRINGS

Step1: Connect a jumpring to a bead tip.



Step2: hang a jumpring into the bead tip and close it.



Step3: Make the loop tightly.



Step4: Repeat above steps on another end of the part.



Step5: Slightly open the jumpring with flat nose pliers.



Step6: Connect a lobster claw clasp to the jumpring and close it.



Step7: Then you can connect the two ends of the jewelry.



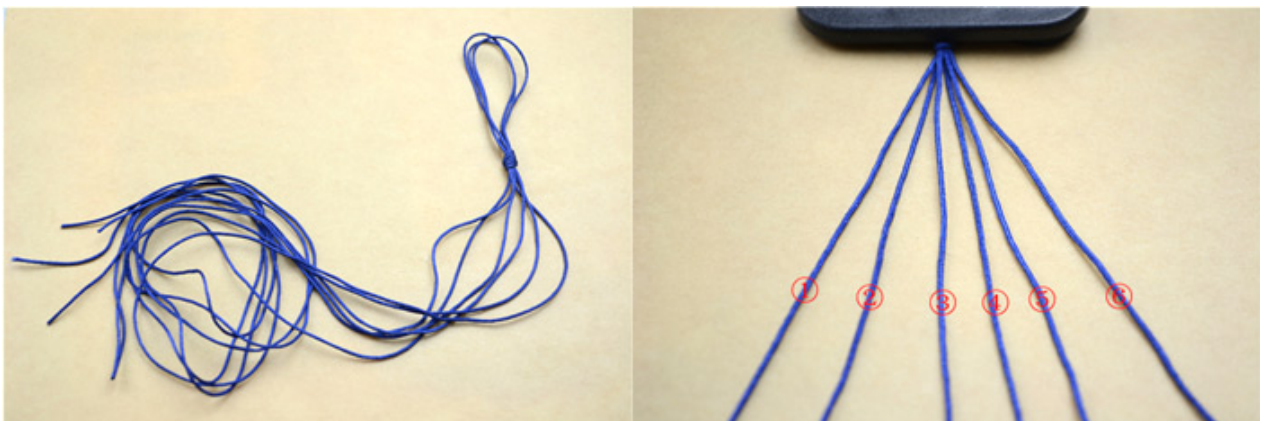
FRIENDSHIP BRACELET MODEL A



Step1: thread preparation

Snip six 50cm long Nylon Thread strands from the coil; tie a knot at the location beside 10cm long from beginning thread tips.

Tips: when prepare the basic thread strands for a friendship bracelet, the thread ① and ⑥, as the main working ends, should be twice longer than the rest four threads.

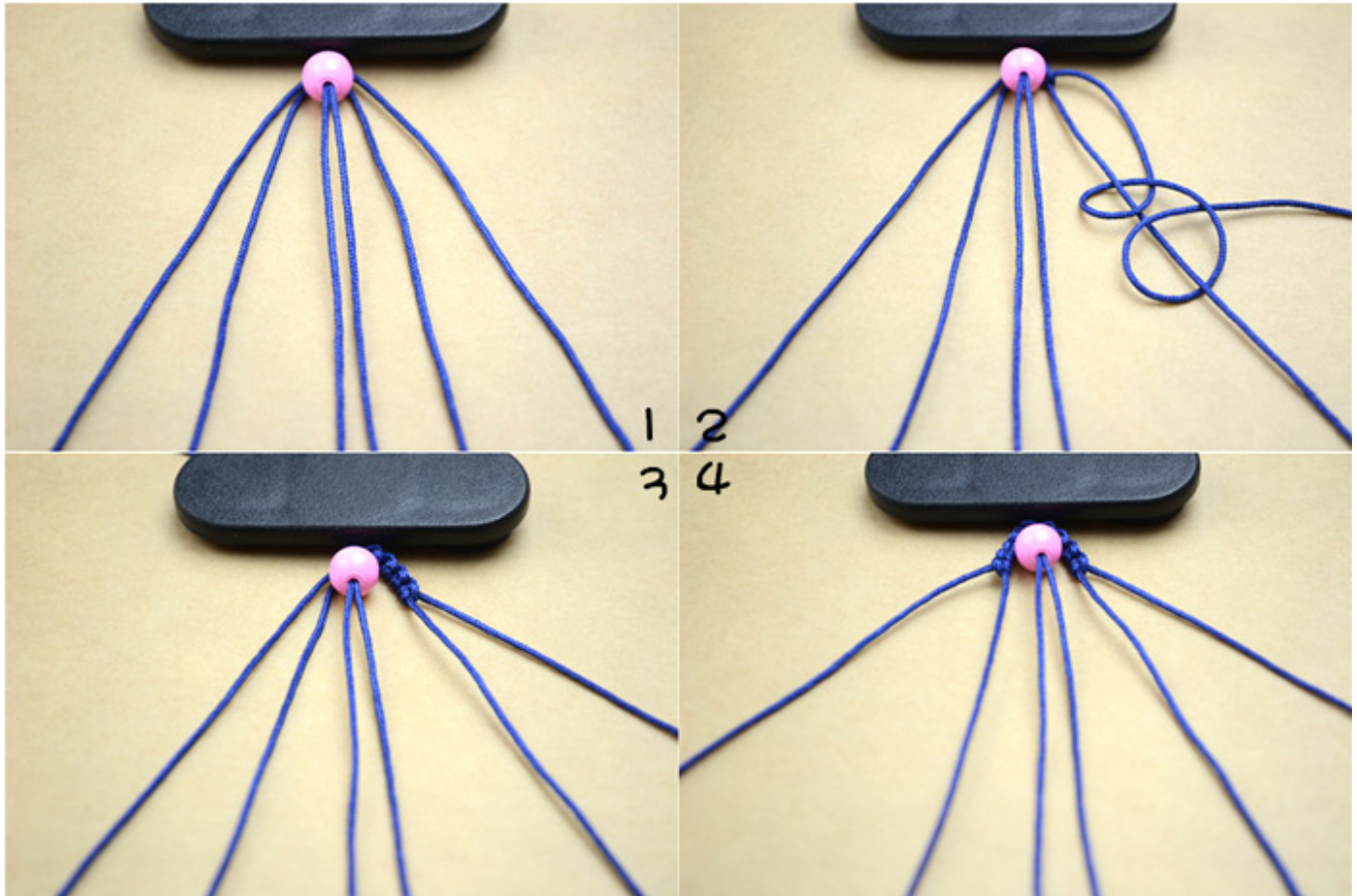


Step2: add on the first bead for your friendship bracelet

Take the thread ③ and ④, regard them as the first holding thread and string one 8mm Gemstone Bead on;

Secondly, pick up the thread ⑥ to make the basic larks head knots with thread ⑤ four times as the picture show;

At last, repeat the same processes with thread ① and ②.



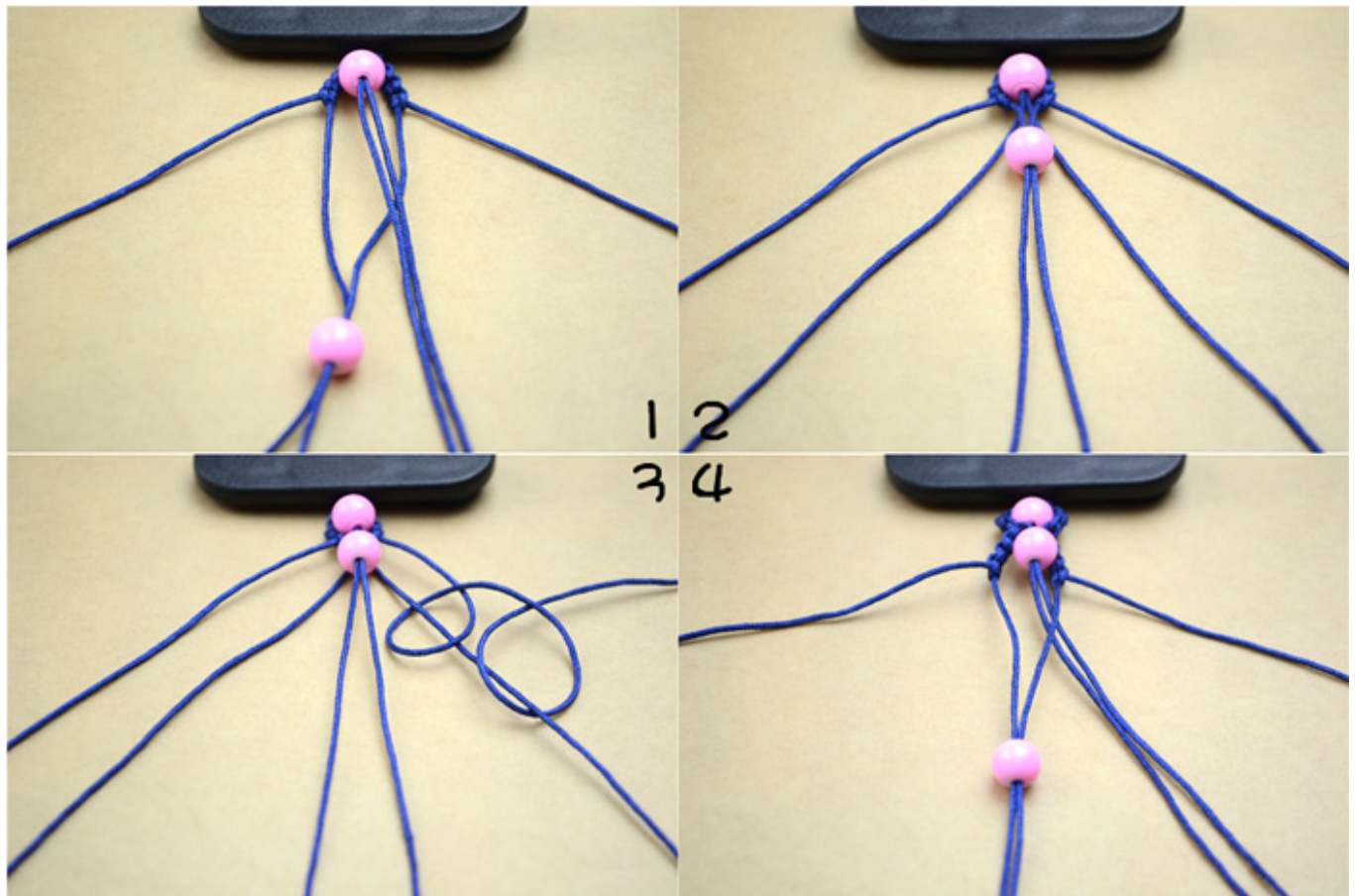
Step3: change the two main holding threads and add on the second Gemstone bead

Firstly, pick out the thread ② and ⑤ and string one 8mm Gemstone Bead according to the diagram;

Secondly, place the new holding threads over previous group and separate them left and right;

Thirdly, repeat making four of the basic larks head knots;

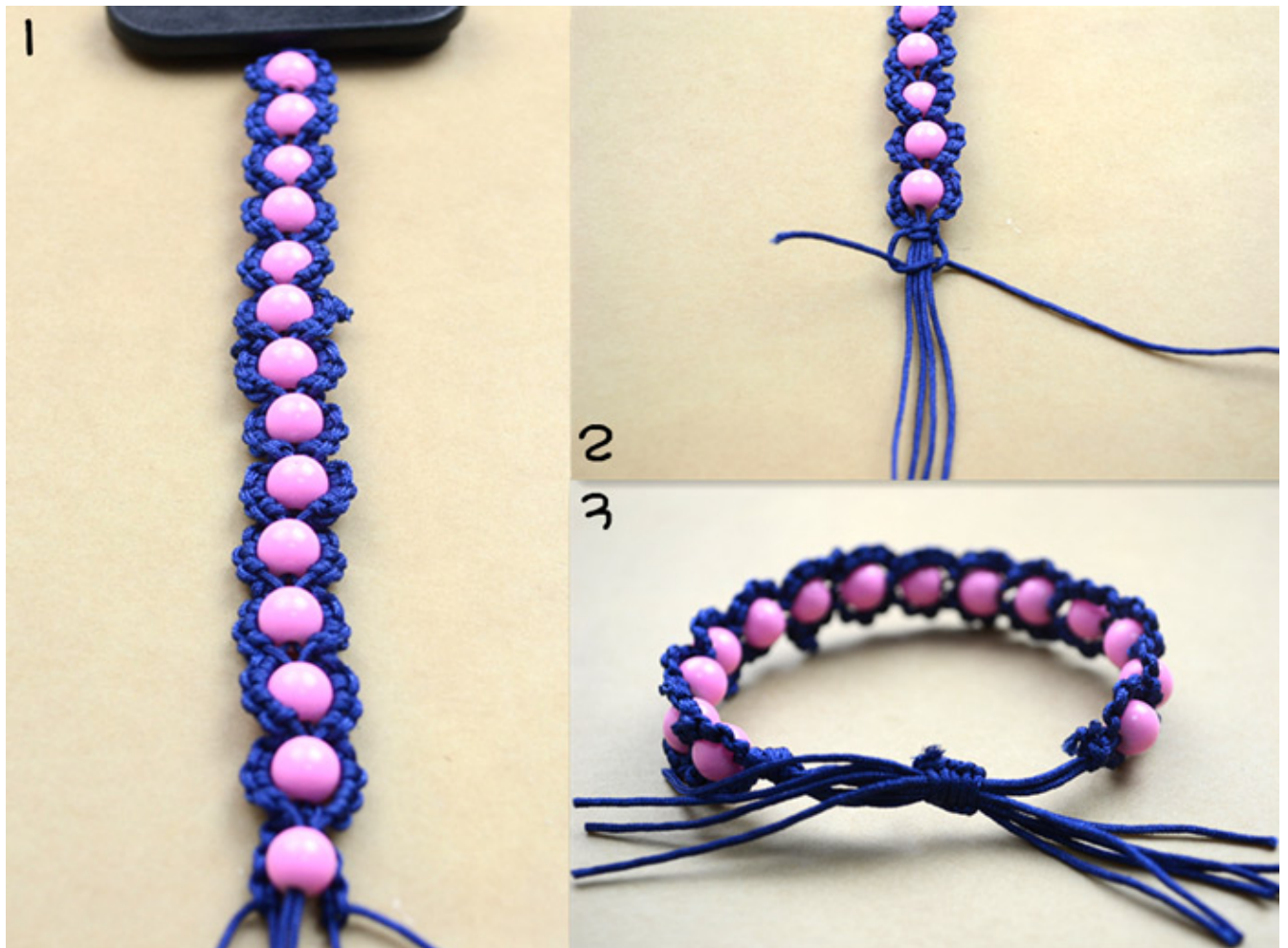
Finally, repeat the step1 and step2 for more knots and beads groups to complete the friendship bracelet.



Step4: make the closure portion of friendship bracelet

Firstly, when the bracelet reaches the ideal length, finish the ending portion by making square knots with two outside thread ends;

Then, place the two tips of bracelet cross on a desk and then take an extra strand of Nylon thread to tie more square knots.



Since finish the square knots, you have completed the whole steps for a custom friendship bracelet! Additionally, in order to avoid the square knot from dispersing, fire the thread ends with lighter slightly.

How to make easy friendship bracelets out of Carrick Bend and Alpine Bend

Summary: By learning How to make easy friendship bracelets after today's instructions, you will grasp two kinds of old knots tying ways: Carrick Bend and Alpine Bend. Both knots can be used in your friendship bracelet as their easy to do and undo, and meanwhile difficult to slip and fray.

Who doesn't love friendship bracelet? They are always stylish, funky, fashionable and marvelous. Wear them out together with your friends and you will receive countless admiration and envy. Therewithal, you may ask where to buy friendship bracelet? No! Why not try making one significant one by yourself? In this tutorial, I will just show you how to make easy friendship bracelet out of two knots at home.



Things you may need in the friendship bracelet:

1mm Nylon Thread (red & yellow)

8mm Acrylic Bead

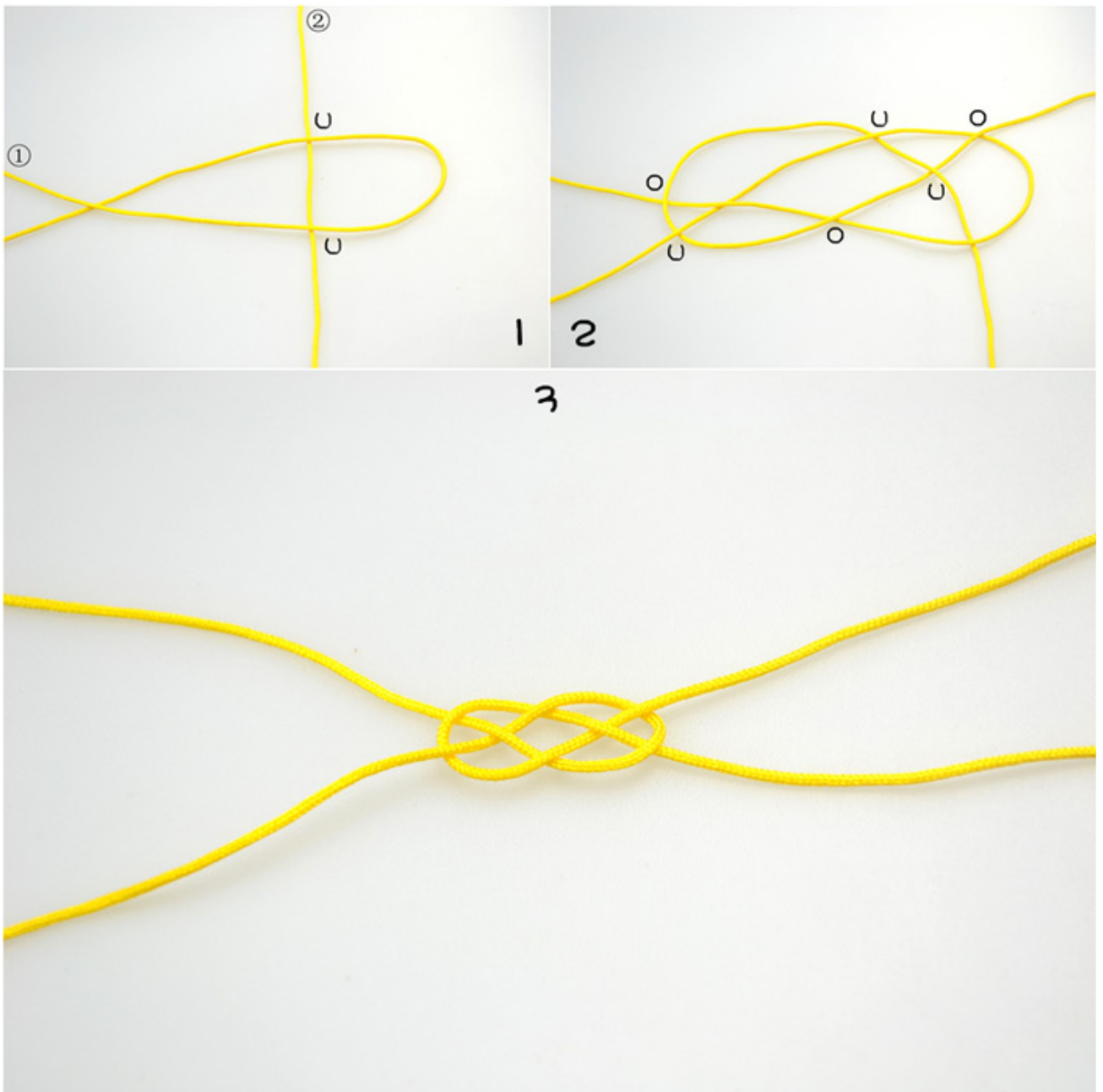
Scissors



Step1: make the decorative Carrick Bend

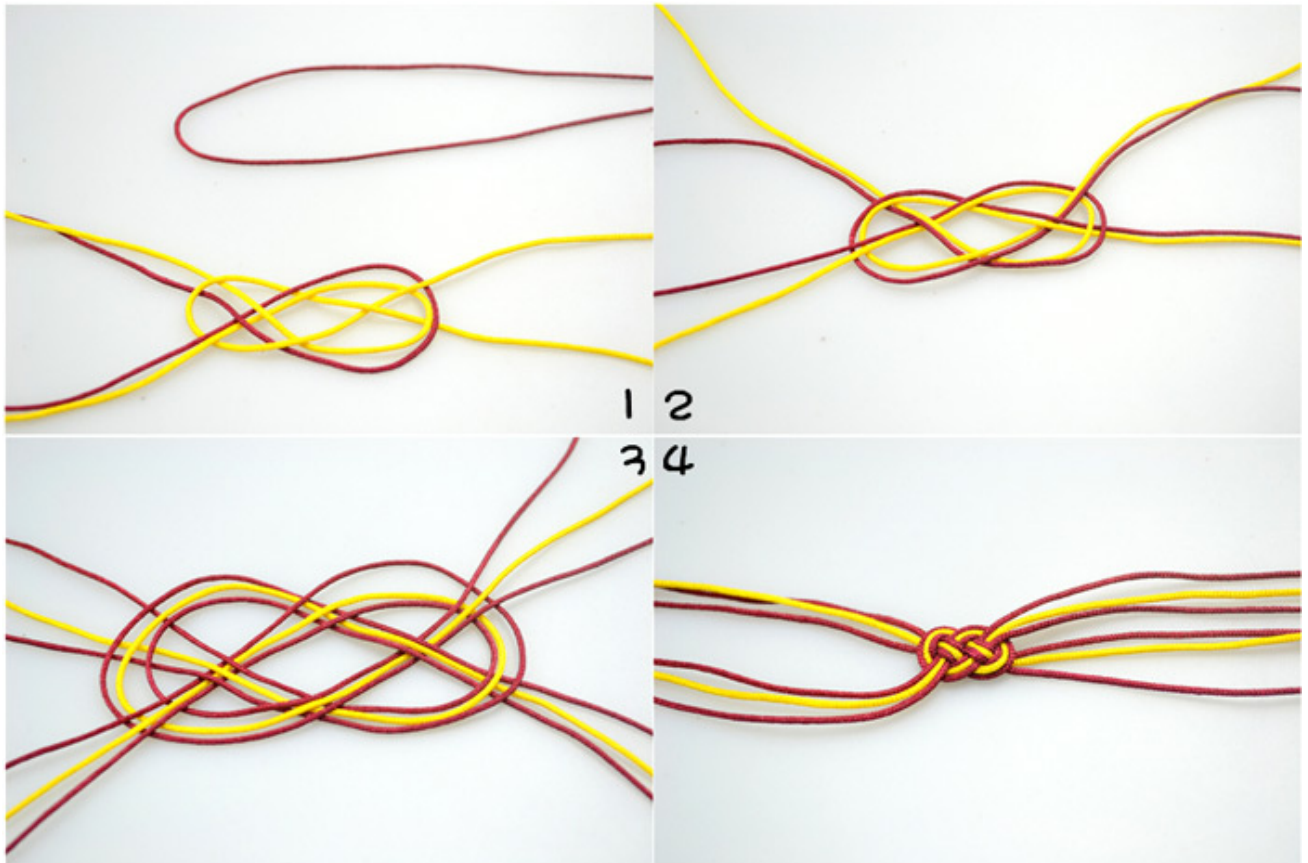
Measure the size of your wrist size and then snip two strands of yellow nylon wire about 20cm longer than that (usually each should be kept 35cm long); next, you can start to make the Carrick Bend for your friendship bracelet:

1. Fold the thread ① and lay its below tip across the another one; then put the thread ② under the folded location of thread ①;
2. Hold the above half tip of thread ② to weave through the existed thread sections over and under according the diagram shows;
3. Adjust the four thread tips and slightly tighten the thread.



Step2: Complete the Carrick Bend for friendship bracelet

1. As shown in the diagram 1 & 2, take another two 35cm long red thread strands and weaving in the corresponding methods along the outer edge of the yellow ones;
2. In the next, repeat the same processes along the inner of yellow ones with two 90cm long red threads.
3. Ensure the red threads staying beside the yellow ones and then pull tightly all the threads.



Step3: make the Alpine Bend for rest friendship bracelet portion

According to the diagrams shows, the rest portion of bracelet is consisting of mass Alpine Bends.



Step4: make the closure

When there only remains two wire ends in each side, cross the four ends and take another wire strand to make a natural closure by the square knot.



Here, you have obtained a new fabulous gift for your friends now. The center Carrick Bend, in the friendship bracelet, just rightly symbolize two hand-in-hand person; and the Alpha Bend, which can be tight steady even there is only one of it, just show the forever love between you and your friends.

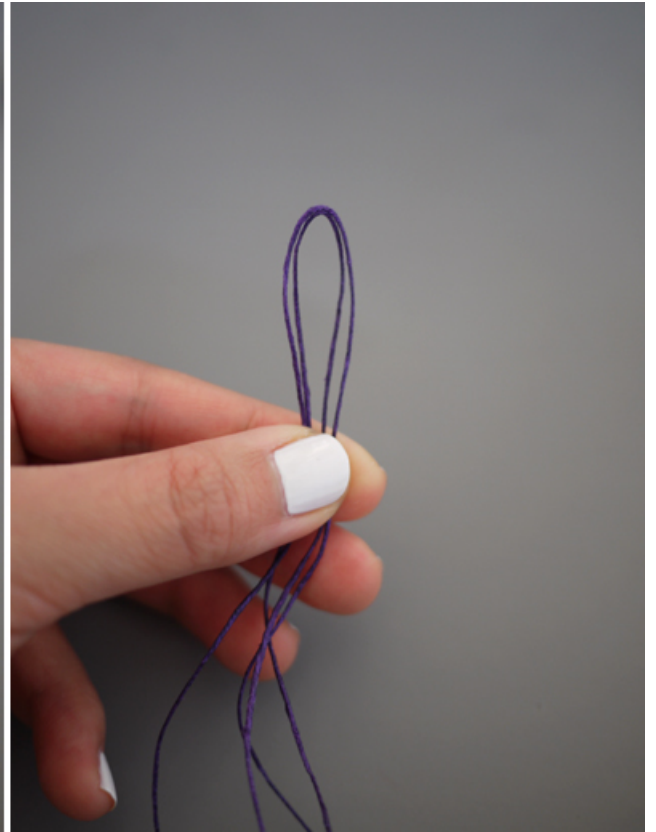
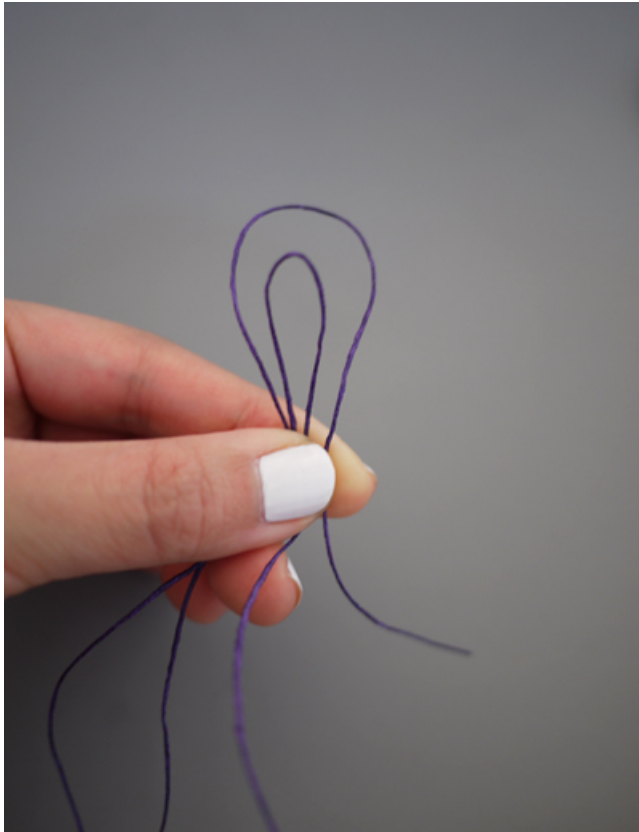
FRIENDSHIP BRACELET MODEL C

You'll need:

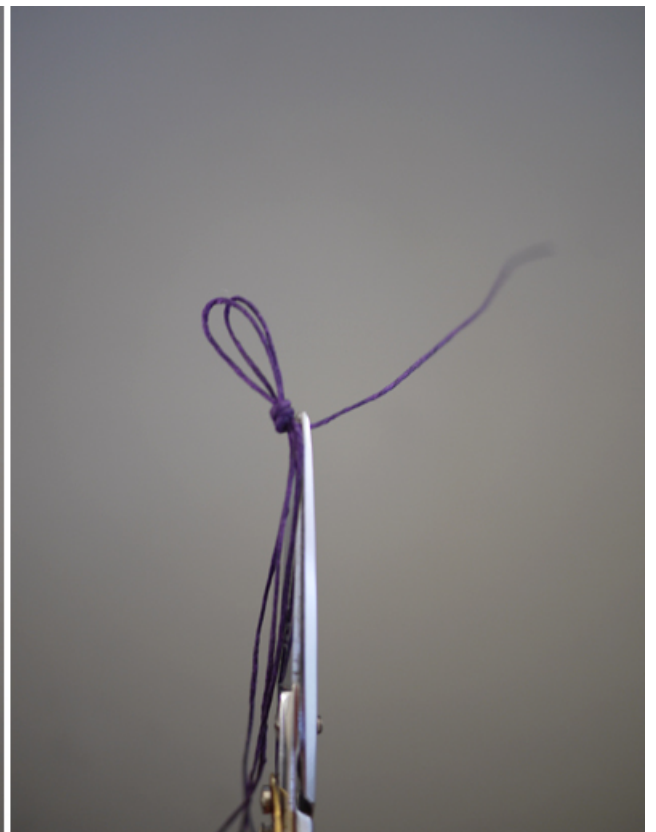
- 1.5 yards of waxed linen cord
- 50 – 70 size 8/0 seed beads
- a 10-13mm two hole button
- scissors



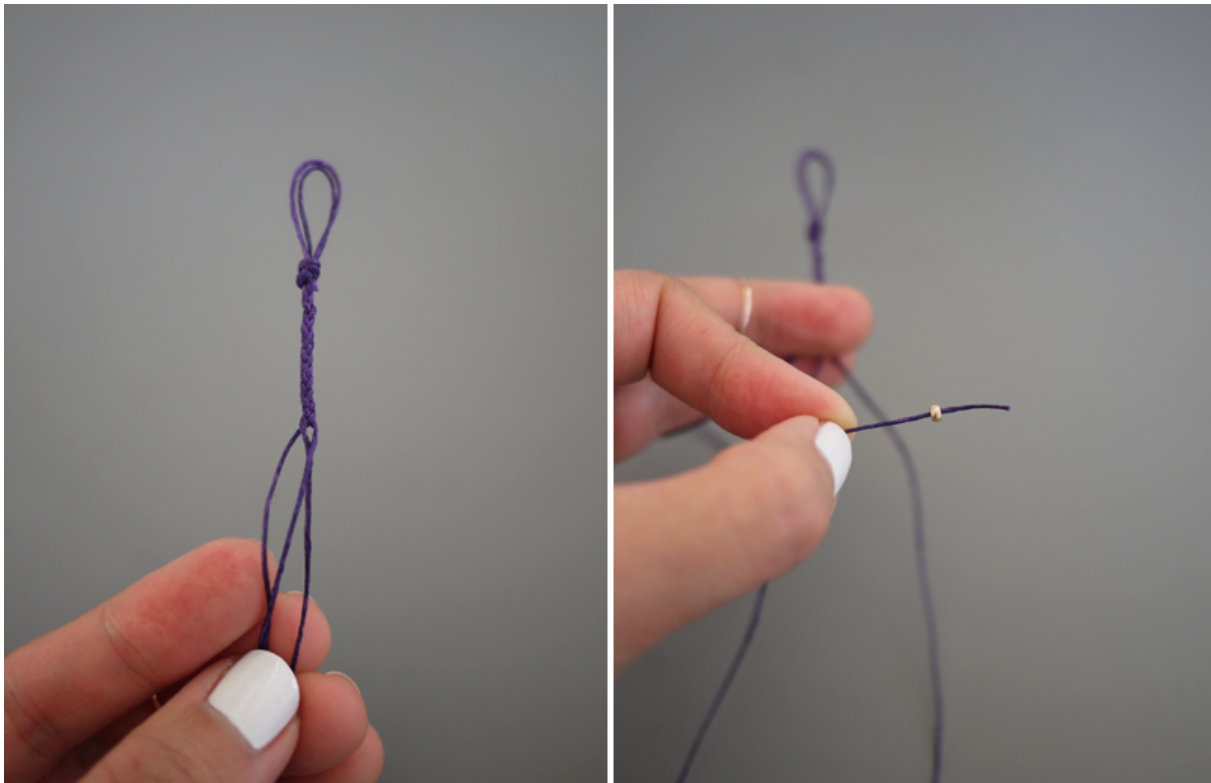
Cut the waxed linen cord into a 26" and 19" piece. Fold the longer strand in half. Align one end of the shorter strand with both ends of the longer strand. Fold the excess over the top of the folded piece creating two parallel loops.



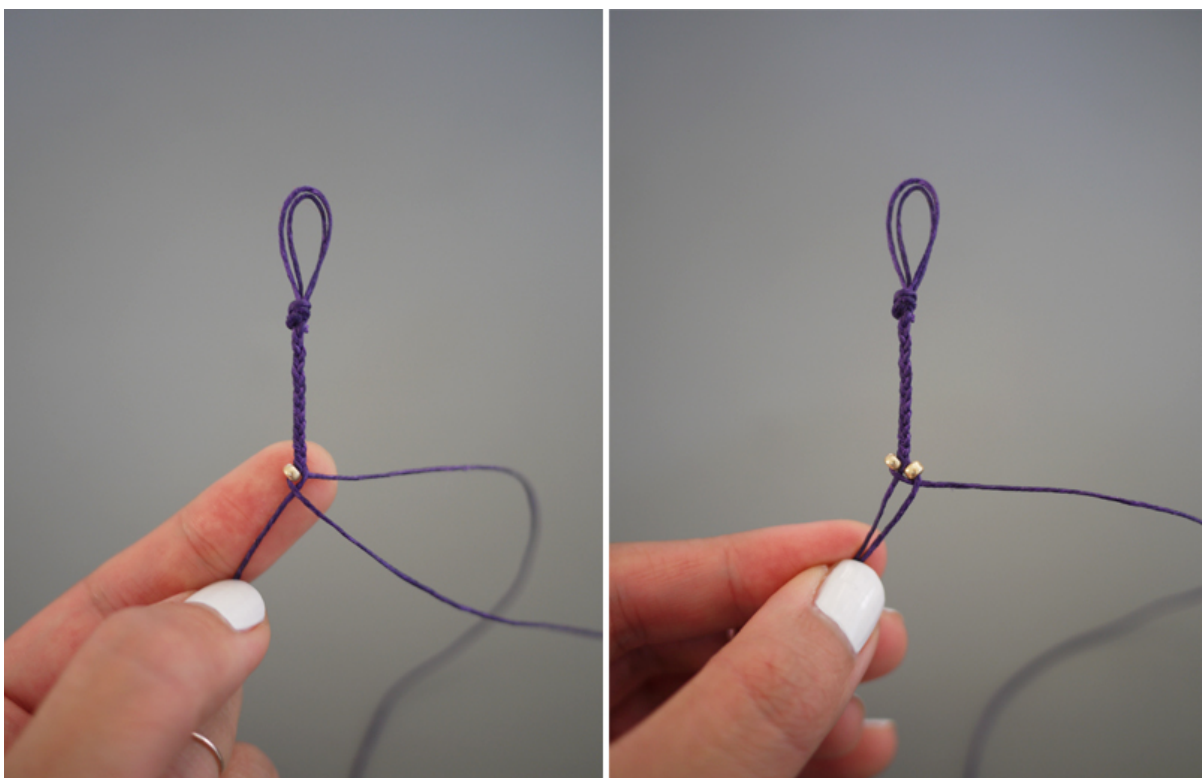
Tie a knot about half an inch down from the loops. Snip off the extra fourth strand, leaving 3 equal strands of equal length.



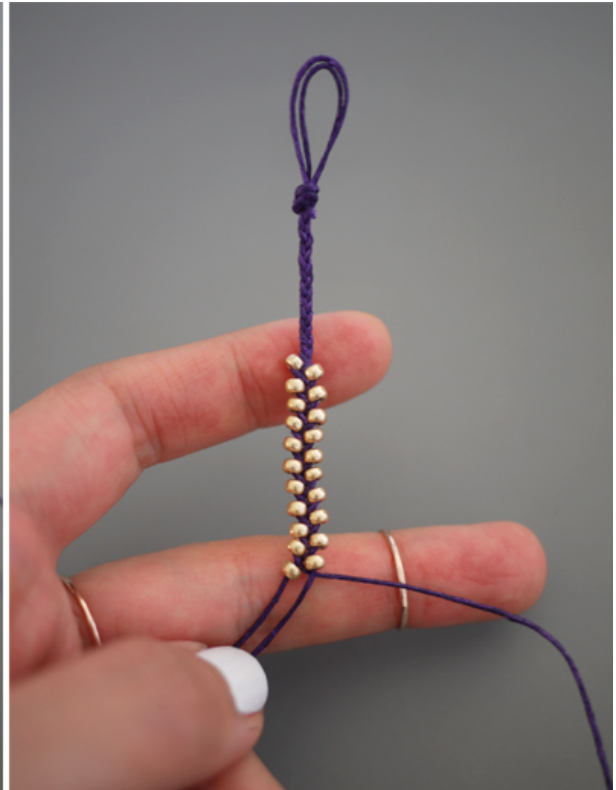
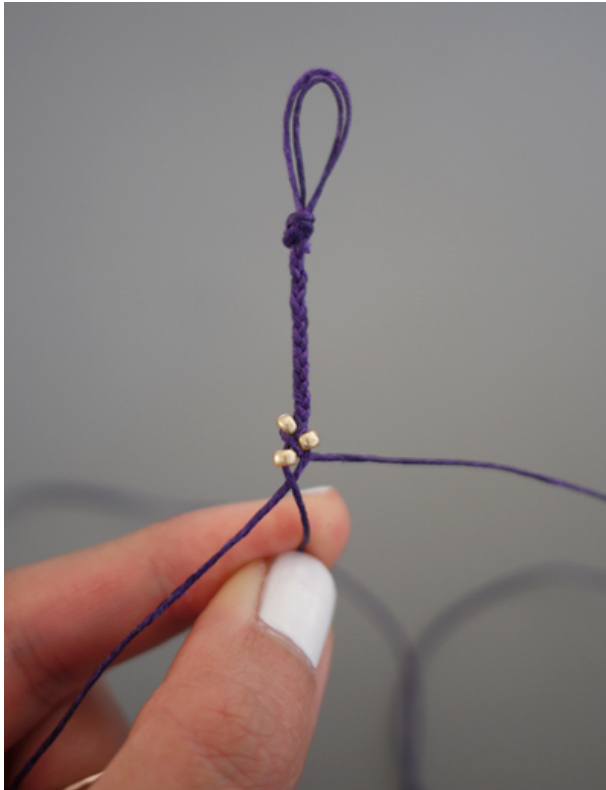
Start braiding the strands. After about an inch or so, braid in the beads. Thread a bead onto the outer left strand.



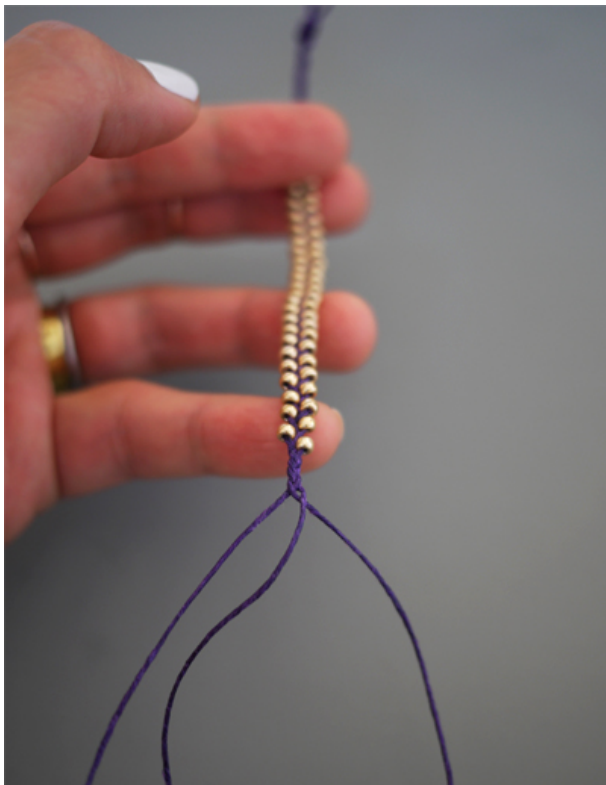
Push the bead against the base of the braid, and cross the left strand over the middle. Now thread another bead onto the outer right strand. Push it to the base of the braid and crossover.



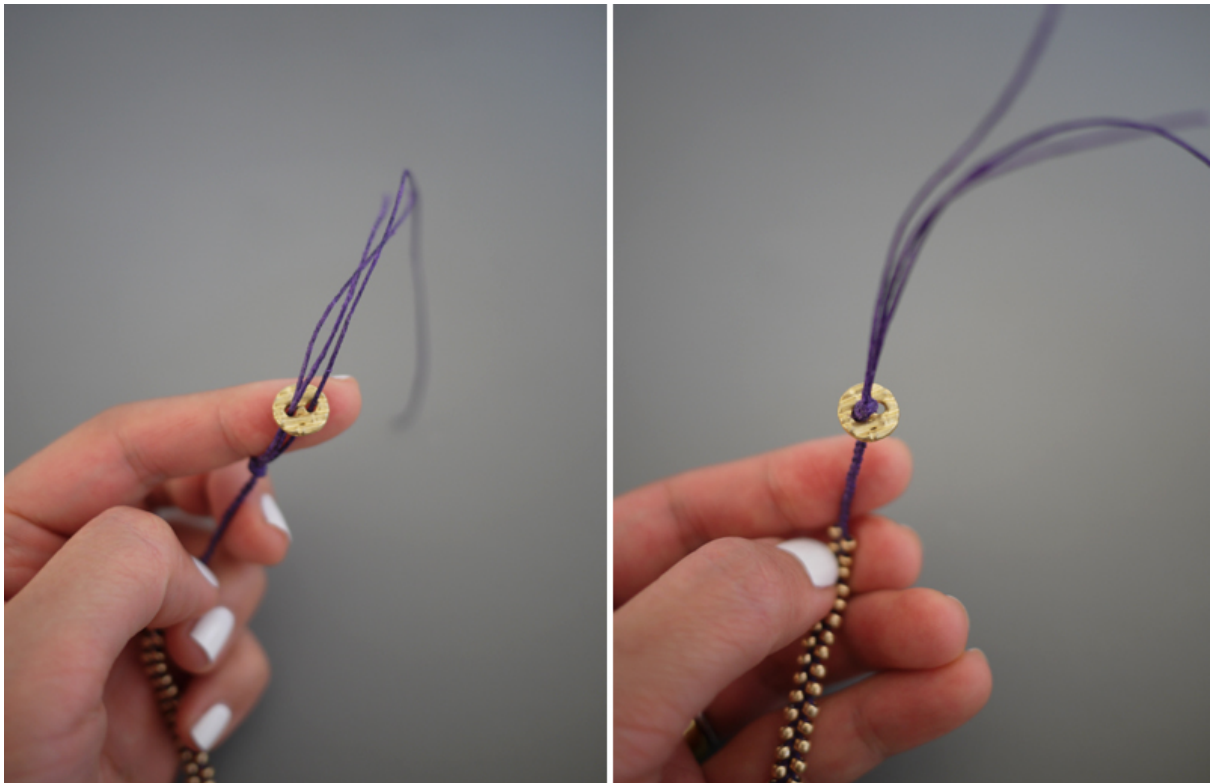
Keep a finger at the base of the braid, holding the beads in their place and keeping the braid tight. Continue threading on beads before each strand is crossed over.



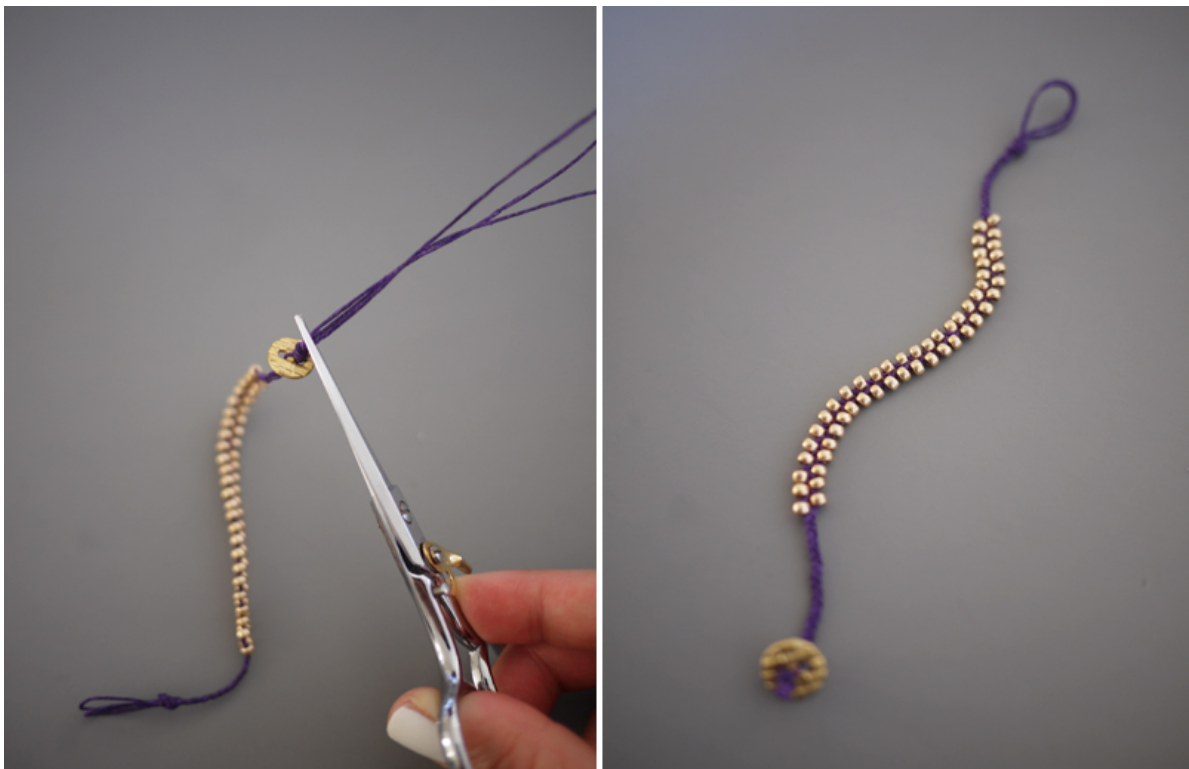
Finish the bracelet with another inch of braided cord, measuring it against the wrist. Tie a knot.



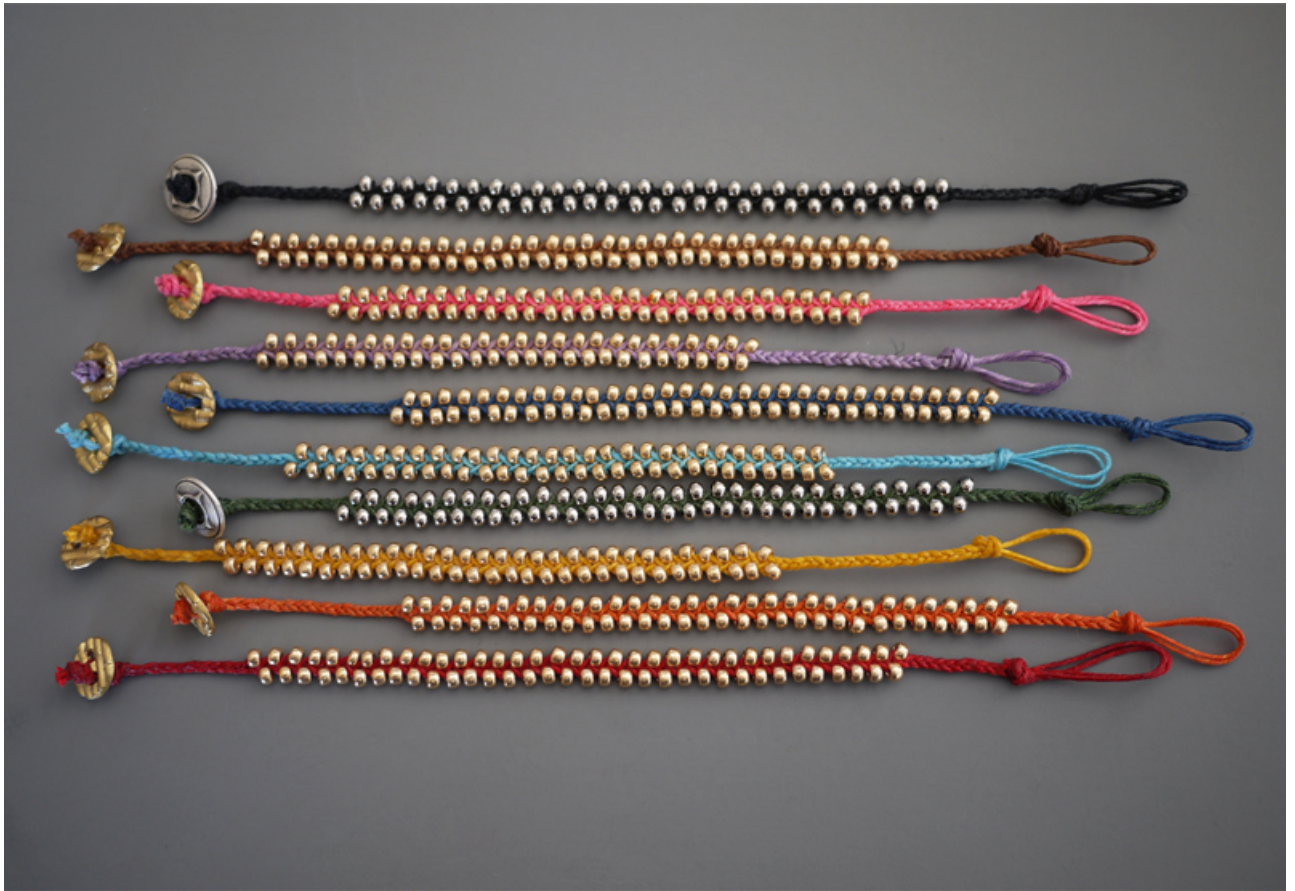
Thread on a two hole button – two strands through one hole and one strand through another.
Secure it with another knot.



Trim the end.



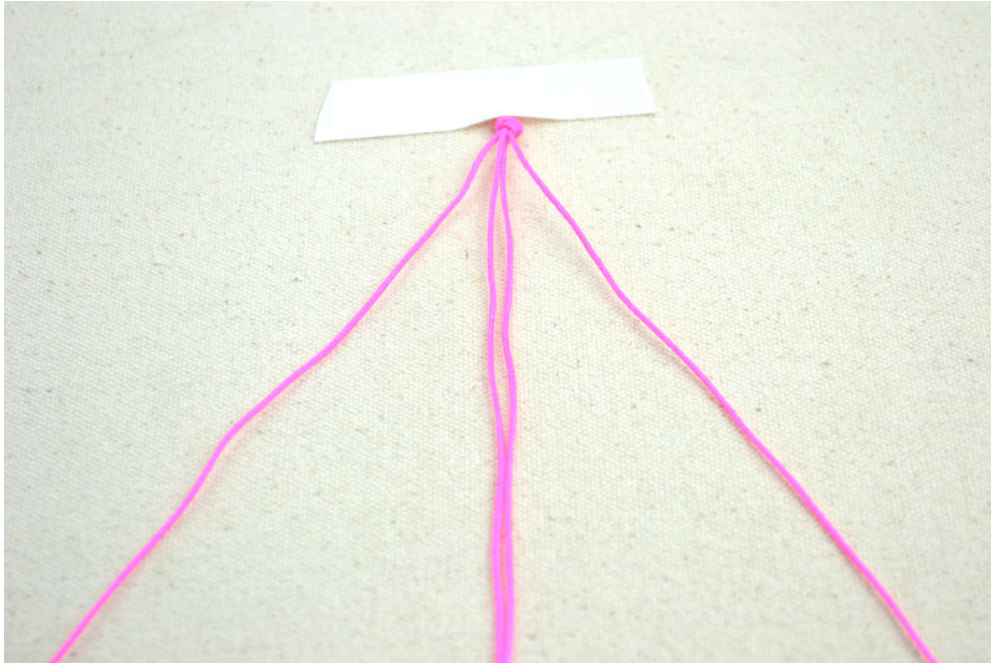
Your bracelet is finished! Try using different colored waxed linen and beads.



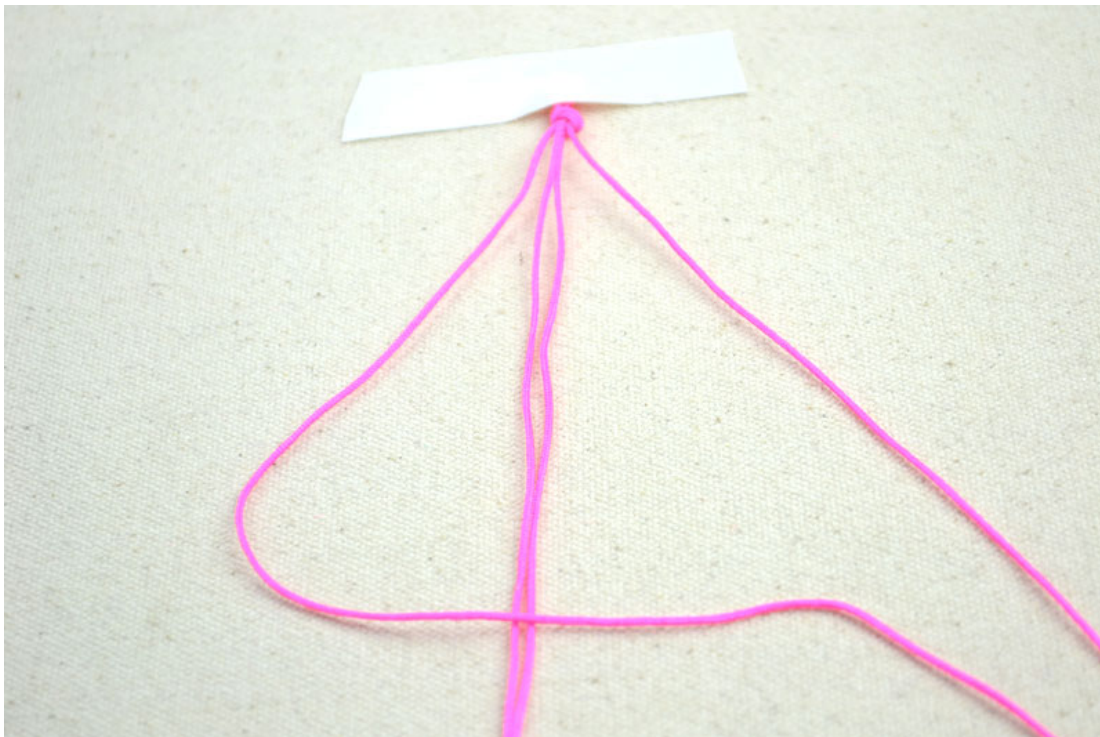
FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS MODEL E

Instructions:

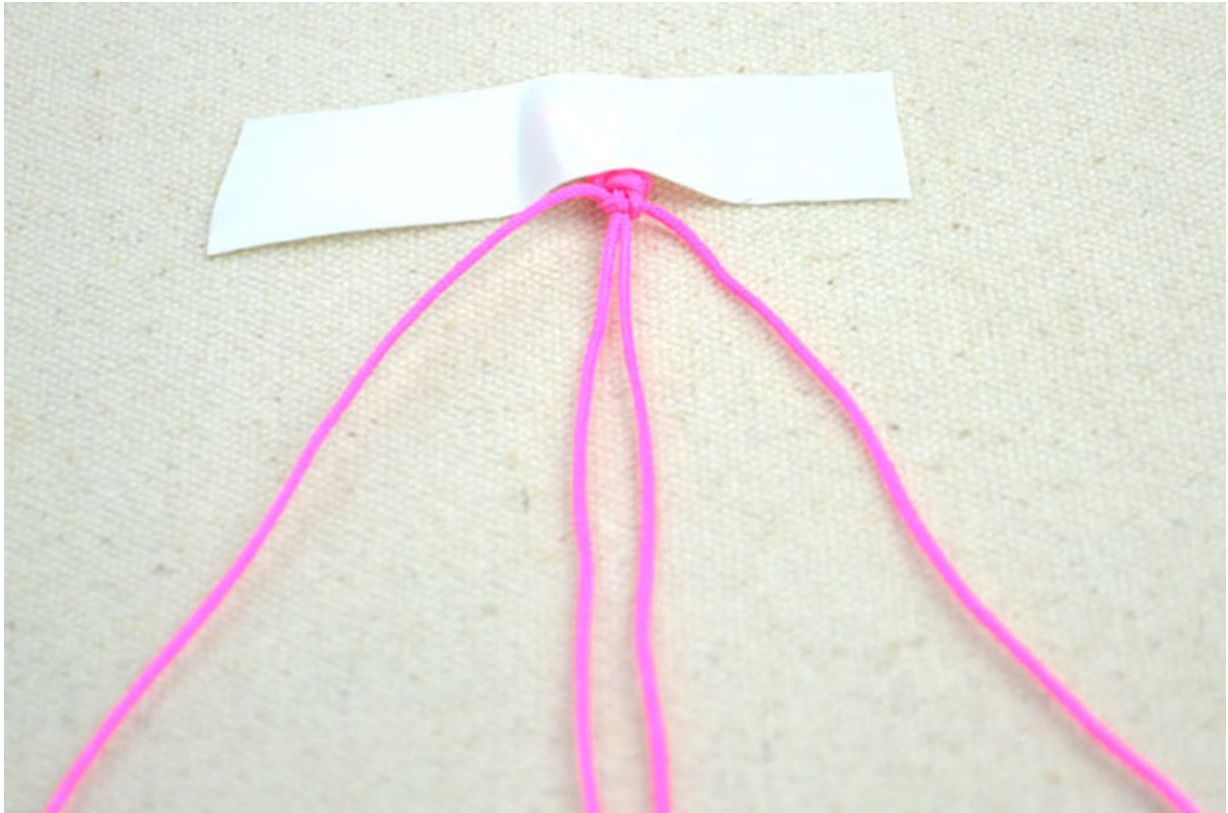
Step1: Prepare four nylon threads and tie them together with a secure knot and the two threads in the middle are holding end, the others on the both sides are working end.



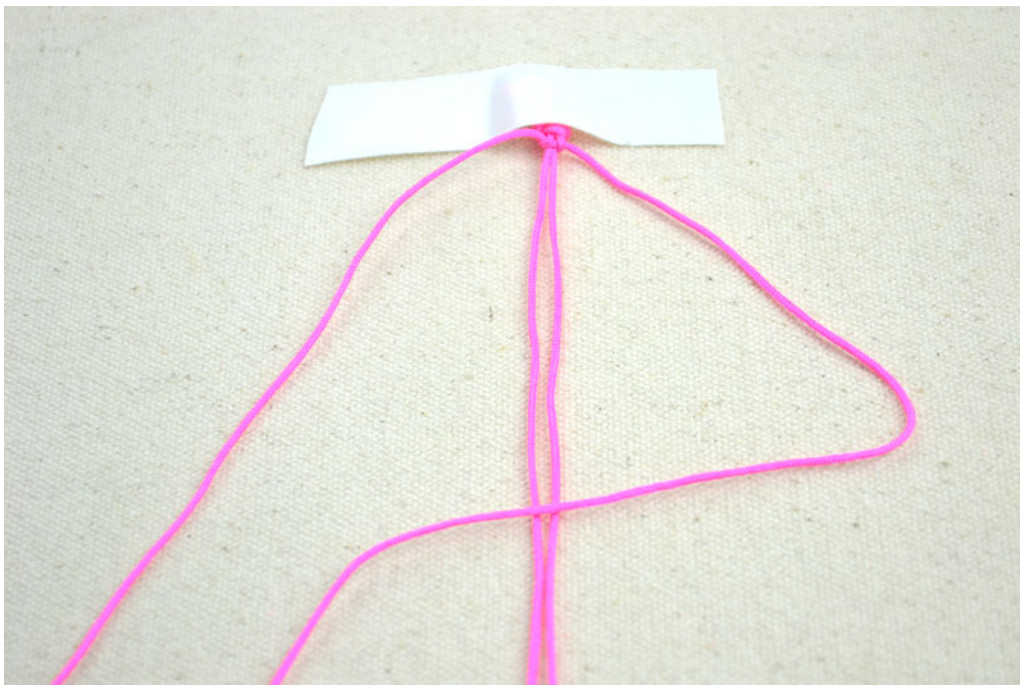
Step2: Cross the left working end over the two holding end.



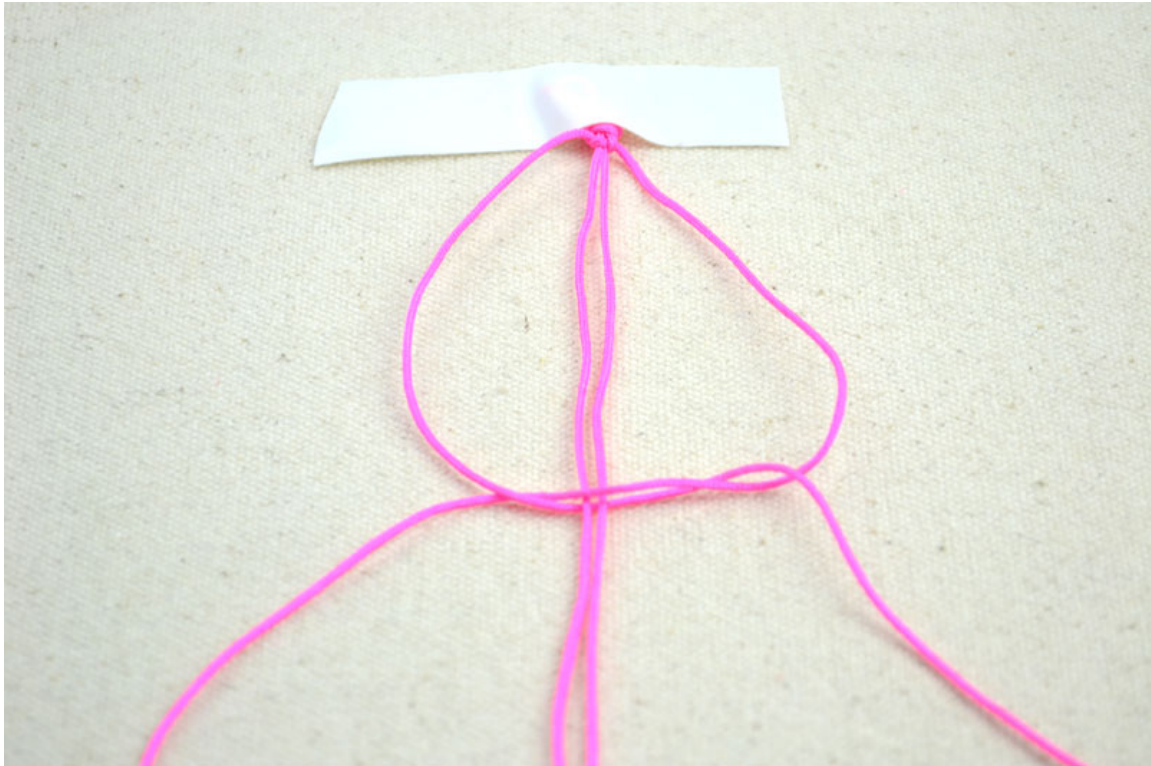
Step3: Cross the right working end over the left one and slip it through the circle under the left thread.



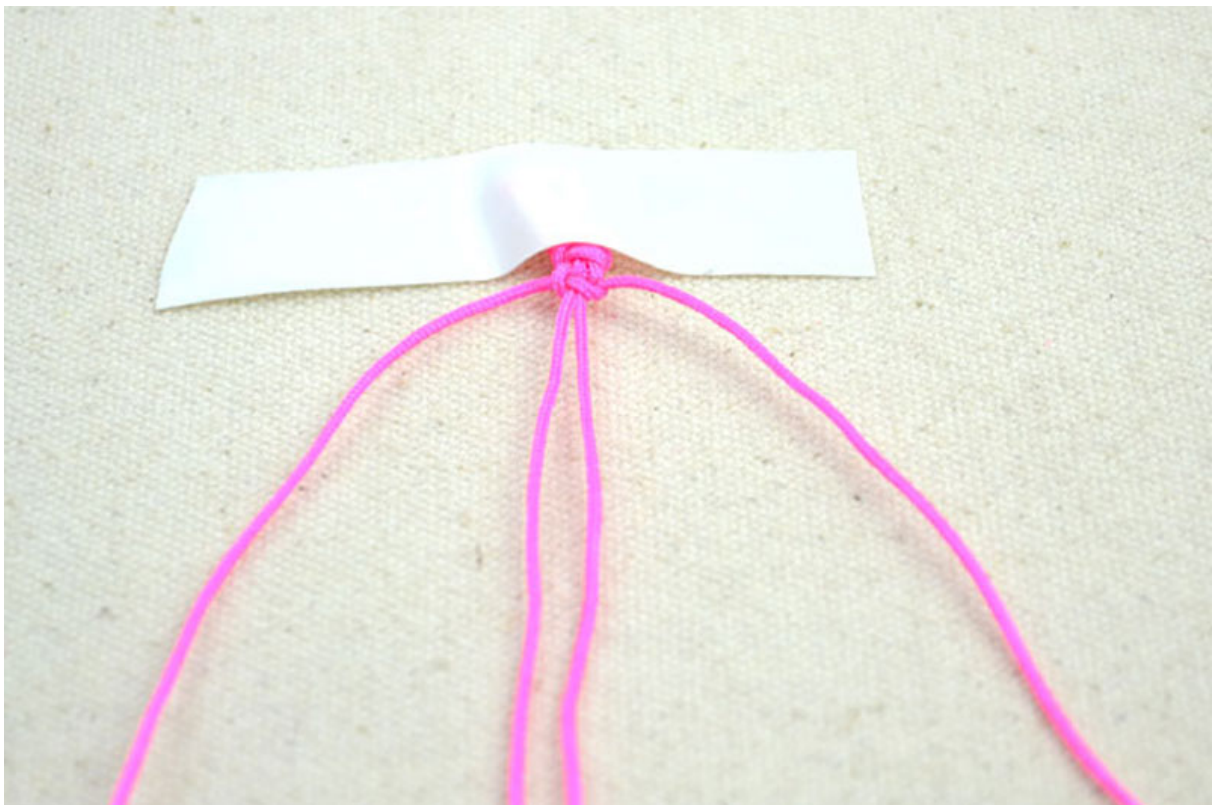
Step4: Cross the left working end over the two middle holding ends.



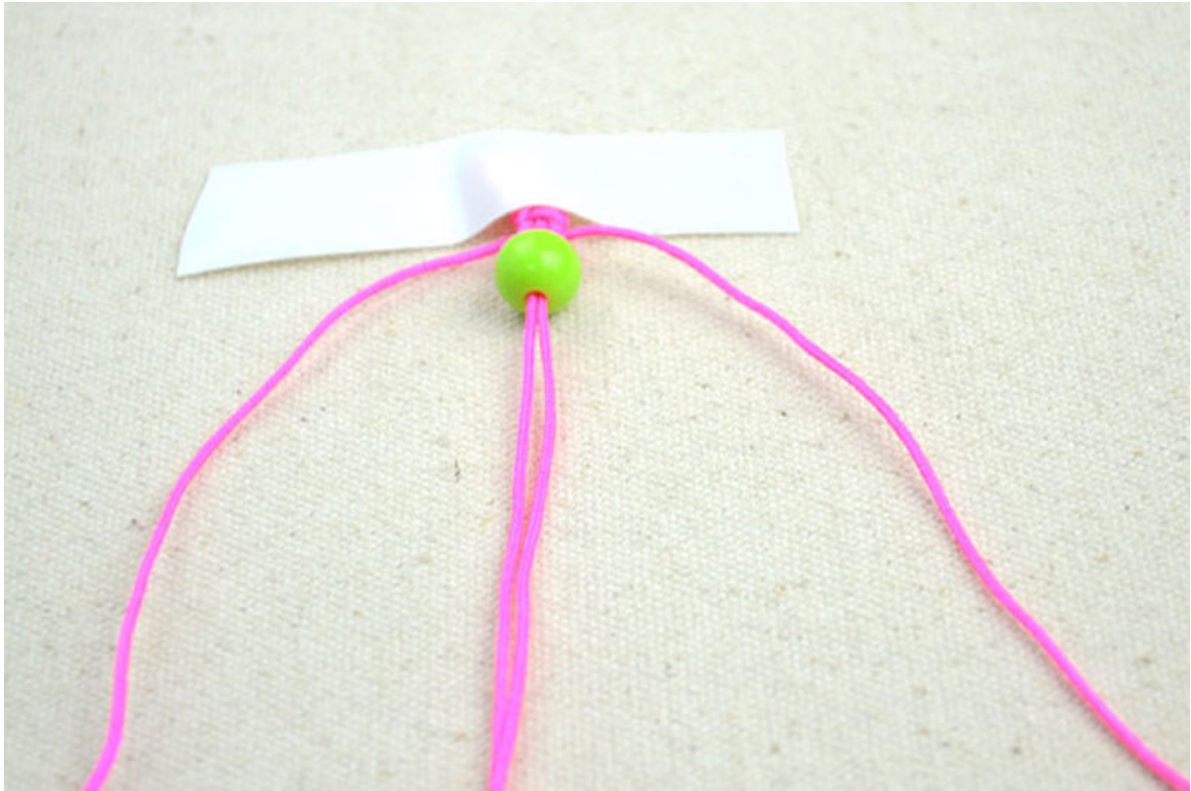
Step5: Repeat the step3.



Step6: Strain the threads on the two sides.



Step7: Slide a bead onto the two middle threads.



Step8: Repeat the above steps until you think it's long enough.
